HUIRANGI SCHOOL APPLICATION TO ENROL NEW ENTRANTS IN 2019

Under our Enrolment Scheme guidelines the Board of Trustees has determined that **six [6]** places are likely to be available for 'out of zone' students who will be starting school in 2019 as a new entrant. The exact number of places available will depend on the number of enrolments received from students who live within the school 'home zone'.

Applications for enrolment for an 'out of zone' student is to be made by completing an enrolment form available from the school office. The deadline for receipt of this application is <u>Tuesday 25th September</u> <u>2018.</u>

Parents who live within the 'home zone' and intend enrolling their child in 2019 should also apply before this deadline to allow the school the opportunity to plan for the 2019 year.

If the number of 'out of zone' applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot. If a ballot is required, it will be held on Wednesday 26th September 2018. Parents will be informed of the outcome within three school days of the ballot being held.
