Age/Years Jargon: Like all schools, we use 'jargon' that parents might sometimes find confusing! [this has been highlighted in recent events]

When we talk about Year 5 for instance, this is NOT about children who are aged 5 years! Primary Schools start at Year 1 and go up to Year 6. Intermediate School is for Year 7 & 8's and High School Years 9 to 13.

Here at Huirangi [as a rough guide]: He Puāwai has Year 1 children who are 5 vears old.

Room 2 has Year 1 & 2 children who are aged between 5 & 6 years old.

Room 1 has Year 2 & 3 children who are aged between 6 to 7 years old.

Room 3 has Year 4 & Year 5 children aged between 7 and 10 years old and

Room 4 has Year 5 & 6 children aged between 9 and 11 years old.
