Dear Parents and Caregivers

I hope everyone has had a lovely long Queens Birthday weekend!

A heartfelt thankyou to those of you who continue to support the Teachers with the current industrial action and who supported us on the strike day last week.

The Rippa Rugby Tournament due to be played tomorrow has been put off till Monday 10th, due to the weather and commitments that other schools have on the postponement date. To the families who offered transport [Treweek / Alldridge /Farquhar / Anglesey / Brett] please give the office a call to let us know if you are still OK for Monday. Also, if there is any change to what we already know about your child meeting us at the venue, and walking home afterwards, please let us know.

We have been contacted by the Ministry of Health [MOH] to advise parents some important information about measles. An outbreak [or even 1 case] is very disruptive for schools. It is a severe disease and most people need to spend several weeks off school or work because they are so sick. Measles are a notifiable disease, so if your child contracts them [or even if you suspect they may have then], please **keep them at home, get them checked by a doctor** and **alert school** straight away. Children who are NOT immunised will need to stay home from school too until the risk of getting measles has passed [**this is 14 days**]. So please, for the good of the health of everyone at our school and in our community, be very vigilant and ensure your children are immunised against this disease. 
