2020 Activity Account: You may have heard through various media that in 2020 the government is donating \$150 per child to the schools that qualify and opt into this scheme. Our school is eligible so we have chosen to join the scheme and there are a number of rules set out as to what this donation will cover and there are restrictions on what we will be able to ask parents to pay for. Families can still give donations to schools if they so choose, but school cannot *ask* for a donation. This table shows simply what our school can, and cannot, ask families to pay:-
