Pickup Time Procedure: We ask that parents/caregivers on after school pick up, to please park and walk into the school main gate to collect your child/children. As there will be higher traffic movement within this area at this time, we need to ensure children's safety. We will monitor this over the coming weeks and modify if necessary.

Stationery: All stationery items are supplied from school at a cost of \$30 per child. Please pay this amount to school sometime within the first 2 weeks of term. Should you wish to use internet payments, use your child's name as reference along with the word 'stationery' into 153945 0210342 00. This cost includes a school hat for the *new entrant [5year olds]* too.

Activity fees: Remember there is no charge for this as we have opted into the government donation scheme.

Camp 2020: The Year 5 & 6 students will be going on camp to Camp Okoki for a 2 night stay in the first week of March. A separate note will be sent home with those students. As it is an overnight camp, there will be a part charge.

Swimming: Please ensure children have their togs/towel/swim caps [latex ones are easiest to get on]/goggles [optional] in a waterproof bag, EVERY day. If, for a medical reason, your child cannot swim, please either sent a note/ email to his/her teacher or call the office. Swimming assessments will be carried out this week by teachers and our qualified swimming instructor will begin working with small groups next week.

School Timetable /Drop Off & Pick Up times: This year our school timetable will change to:
