**Pets Day 2020:** Chickens have now been ordered and the pick-up date /time is Tuesday 8th September, between 2.30pm and 3.00pm at the school office. Please bring a small box! Children who have ordered chickens will be given the 'How To raise a Day Old Chicken' booklet this week to take home for you to look through. For Calves and Lambs the cut off entry time is this Friday 14th August so please return the entry forms to the office by then. These children will also be given the 'How to Raise...' booklet for a calf or lamb. Under guidelines from the Ministry of Primary Industries regarding the Mycoplasma Bovis Programme, once again this year we need to keep a 2 metre separation between calves, so we will separate 'farms' again as we did last year, and the calves will likely not take part in the Grand Parade.

We do accept lambs from pre-schoolers on the day, but not calves or chickens or other small pets. If your pre-schooler in bringing a lamb, please let the office know as soon as possible to ensure we have sufficient space to house it on the day.


