- · A reminder, students continue to use shared equipment such as stationery, digital devices and sports equipment. We will continue to focus on good hygiene habits; regular washing of hands, thorough drying of hands, hand sanitiser in every room.
- · School drop off time is as normal no earlier than 8:15am please. Pick up times for all students remains 3pm.
- · Drinking fountains are closed. Each student needs to bring a labelled drink bottle from home.

Again thanks for your understanding and patience through what has been a very disruptive and ever changing school year.

We will remain in this level until the government 're-look' on or about September 14th.

Finally, thanks to parents who returned their Health & PE survey form by last Friday. Your input is much appreciated.
